



Update on Special General Meeting

At the General Meeting of the membership which took place on September 24, 2015 the members in attendance voted unanimously in favor of amending Supplemental Bylaw 6-11. With this vote the sales quorum required to conduct a vote on whether or not to sell the Rocky REA's works has been increased from 20% to 75% of membership. This large quorum will ensure that:

1. if such an event were to occur, the majority of our members would be required to vote on this pivotal decision.
2. the Rocky REA will be further protected from hostile takeover activity.

The turnout at this meeting was excellent with a total of 70 members, 6 staff and 8 Directors present. We understand that it is a busy time of year for many of our members, and we greatly appreciate the support we receive at events such as this.

At the meeting your Chairman, Bob Bryant announced that the Rocky REA recently purchased some land. This land will allow us to build a new facility so that we can grow over time along with the needs of our membership. Our goal is to develop new benefits for our members, including new services. For example, because we already have the infrastructure in place, we are exploring providing fiber-optic, telecomm and security services to our members.

The Rocky REA is committed to learning more about our membership and what services you need. In the coming weeks and months we will be talking to our members about what services they want, what can be improved and how we can be as responsive as possible to the needs of our membership.

Update on Paperless Billing Program

We have had a great response from members regarding the e-billing program outlined below. Many members have provided us with their email addresses and we would like to thank you all for your support and enthusiasm!

Rocky REA is developing an electronic system to improve communication with our members in such areas as pre-planned power outage notifications, important news affecting the power system and billing. Postage and handling savings will be passed on to those members who participate by providing us with a valid email address. This email address will only be used for Rocky REA purposes and not distributed to any other organization.

When our system is fully capable of sending electric service bills electronically (on or before January 2016), members who have provided their email address will begin receiving a \$2.00 per month discount on their administration fee.

Anyone who provides their email address prior to the launch of our new system will have their name entered into a draw for \$250 credit to be applied to their REA bill. (This includes all those who have already provided their email address.)
