## Rocky REA Scholarship Program

\$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to the top two applicants.

Applicants must provide the following:

- An essay describing their study plans and future career goals. The essay should be typed, double-spaced and no longer than 1,000 words
- A copy of their post-secondary institution acceptance letter
- Official Government of Alberta transcripts (once available)
- Two letters of reference either from teachers, employers, coaches, or religious representatives. The letter should describe the qualities the applicant displays which make them an appropriate candidate for this award. For example the letter may include information regarding the applicant's academic standing, achievement in extracurricular activities, and/or community involvement.
